Proof of correct operation and safety, especially the points listed below:

## Playground

Date of installation
Checks depend on the type of equipment. Any equipment with moving parts must be checked at least twice a year, static equipment equipment at least once a year.

Intervals for maintenance work and checks generally depend on

- location
- usage
- frequency of use
- possible vandalism

## Wooden parts

1. Check for rot and, if necessary, smooth out splinters and round off sharp edges of cracks.
2. Check that all bolts and screws are tight and retighten if necessary.
3. If required, touch up or renew the paintwork using a solvent-free acrylic paint.
4. Recommendation: apply paraffin wax to the upper end grain areas once a year, please refer to order No. 0.90100, 1 litre.

Attached parts
5. Check stainless steel surface for vandalism.
6. Check that baking table, sand shovel and climbing holds are complete and check that all elements are securely connected.

## Structural stability

7. In order to check for corrosion, uncover the foundation once a year.
