Checks depend on the type of equipment. Any equipment with moving parts must be checked at least twice a year, static equipment at least once a year.


Intervals for maintenance work and checks generally depend on

	Wooden parts	
-	Check for rot (frequent cleaning prevents excessive rotting) and, if necessary, smooth out splinters and round off sharp edges of cracks.	
2	Check that all bolts and screws are tight and retighten if necessary.	
3.	Correct warping and/or swelling by grinding with sand paper.	
	Functional parts	
•	Check all functional parts for smooth motion. Renew worn parts if necessary.	
	Structural stability	
5.	In order to check the steel feet for corrosion, uncover the foundation once a year.
